### Proverbs 20:16-30

Take his garment that is surety for a stranger: and take a pledge of him for a strange woman. Bread of deceit is sweet to a man; but afterwards his mouth shall be filled with gravel. Every purpose is established by counsel: and with good advice make war. He that goeth about as a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips. Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness. An inheritance *may be* gotten hastily at the beginning; but the end thereof shall not be blessed. Say not thou, I will recompense evil; *but* wait on the LORD, and he shall save thee. Divers weights *are* an abomination unto the LORD; and a false balance *is* not good. Man's goings *are* of the LORD; how can a man then understand his own way? *It is a* snare to the man *who* devoureth *that which is* holy, and after vows to make enquiry. A wise king scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them. The spirit of man *is* the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly. Mercy and truth preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy. The glory of young men *is* their strength: and the beauty of old men *is* the gray head. The blueness of a wound cleanseth away evil: so *do* stripes the inward parts of the belly.
